OCT 1, 2019: LISBON Bem vindo a Portugal! Meet your Encore Tour Manager and transfer to your hotel in Lisbon. Begin to unlock the secrets of this fascinating city, once the capital of the world's greatest maritime empire, with your Tour Manager this afternoon, followed by a welcome dinner together! (D)

OCT 2, 2019: LISBON After breakfast, which is included each morning of the tour, visit the hillside town of Sintra and its beautiful Pena Palace. The Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, constitutes one of the major expressions of 19th-century Romanticism in the world. Continue to Obidos where you will walk the gorgeous historic center, famed for its labyrinth of cobblestoned streets and flower-bedecked, whitewashed houses. OCT 4, 2019: SEVILLE After breakfast, depart across the plains of the Alentejo region towards the city of Evora. Stop to stretch your legs, visit the old quarter of this medieval city and have some leisure time for lunch on your own. This afternoon, perform an afternoon concert at Evora Cathedral (pending approval). Then continue to Seville where upon arrival, you will check in to your hotel and have dinner together. (B,D)

OCT 5, 2019: SEVILLE Discover Andalucía's loveliest city on a morning sightseeing tour, including Christopher Columbus' tomb in the Cathedral. Enjoy views from the grand Giralda Tower and learn about Seville's important past. This afternoon after lunch there will be some leisure time for shopping or exploring the city on your own. This evening, perform your next concert for the people of Seville. Venue options include El Divino Salvador Church, Santa Maria la Blanca Church or the Anunciacion Church. Enjoy dinner together this evening. (B,D)

OCT 6, 2019: GRANADA This morning, visit Córdoba, where you will enjoy entrance to the city's famous Moorish Mezquita, an immense mosque dating from 784 A.D., featuring a columned prayer hall and older Byzantine mosaics. It became a Catholic church in 1236 and a Renaissance-style nave was added in the 17th century. Then depart for the enchanted Moorish city of Granada. As the English Poet Laurie Lee described, Granada is the most beautiful and haunting of all Spanish cities; an African paradise set under the Sierras like a rose preserved in snow. Check in to your hotel and enjoy dinner together. Granada is heralded as the birthplace of flamenco, which you will see in action during an authentic flamenco performance in the Sacromonte Caves this evening. (B,D)

OCT 7, 2019: GRANADA After breakfast, your morning guided sightseeing tour will include the Alhambra Palace, one of the greatest accomplishments of Islamic art and architecture; also included are the beautiful Generalife Gardens! Enjoy some free time for lunch and shopping this afternoon. Then rehearse for your next concert performance, which will take place this evening. Venue options include Las Angustias Church, Manuel de Falla Auditorium, or San Jeronimo's Monastery. Enjoy dinner on your own tonight. (B)

OCT 8, 2019: MADRID This morning, enjoy some free time to explore and shop in Granada before checking out of the hotel and boarding the bus. Then pass through the legendary plains of La Mancha, land of Don Quixote, en route to the vibrant Spanish capital of Madrid. Check in to your hotel. Then dine like a true madrileño and sample traditional Spanish delicacies during a special tapas evening. You'll try different local specialties as you sidle up next to

the locals for whom this is a culturally important and typical way to spend an evening! (B,D)

OCT 9, 2019: MADRID Madrid's rich heritage comes alive on your guided sightseeing tour of classic Spanish boulevards, grand plazas, and the diverse architecture of modern-day Madrid. Highlights include the Plaza de España with its statue of Don Quixote, the majestic Alcalá Gate, and the famous bullring Las Ventas. Then visit the magnificent Prado, one of the world's premier art museums which features artwork of Velázquez, Goya, Raphael, Rubens, and Bosch. Even the 18th-century Neo-Classical building that houses the collection is stunning. After the tour, you will have some free time to relax, shop, or explore on your own! Tonight, perform your final concert of the tour for the people of Spain! Possible venues include the La Almudena Basilica, San Francisco el Grande church, or the San Antonio de los Alemanes Church. After the concert, enjoy a special private farewell gala dinner together at a local restaurant to celebrate your successful performance tour! (B,D)
